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Grey Coverage Guide

grey coverage formulation guide 1:1.5

COOL result

Choose between natural series 1-10 for fine to normal textured hair or .00 series for medium to coarse textured hair.

WARM result

Choose from .3 series on fine to normal textured hair or .003 on medium to coarse textured hair.

Processing time for optimum grey coverage 45 minutes.

This table provides a guideline for optimum grey coverage results.

Note - Choose between 10 or 20 volume depending on texture of hair and % of grey.

When dealing with difficult to cover grey i.e. 90-100% grey, very coarse, glassy resistant hair we recommend upping the developer to 30 vol. This will not make your colour lighter, however will assist in pushing the colour through to the cortex.

LS: Add 1-5 g / 20g of toner to remove strong yellow pigments and achieve ash/silver blonde result.

PS: Add 3 – 8 g / 20g of toner to remove yellow pigments and achieve smoky/dusky blonde result.

N: Adding 10g Neutral per 20g of toning formula will lighten the shade 1 level and weaken the toning power. It is recommended you add LS or PS when adding Neutral to your toning formula.
